




We Are Specialists In Complex Needs



Team Around The Person

We follow a tiered <u>Positive Behaviour Support</u> (PBS) model. This means that we identify where a person is at, based on their quality of life, and intensify support when we have concerns.





We focus on the future. This is why 38% of the adults in our care have moved from our children's homes, with 67% of our residential homes now providing adult care.

Continuity of care, and supporting people at times of change in their lives is so important to us. This is why transition planning is so well thought out. Our care teams will work diligently to support people to move into our homes, whether this is from their family home, another care provider, or between our own homes. We provide a familiar, consistent and, knowledgeable team who will make the journey easier, and something to look forward to.

We place great emphasis on both nurture and choice, making sure people receiving our care are equipped with the life skills they both want and need, alongside access to specialist support, therapy and care.

Students and people we support can count on us as much as they need and for as long as they need us. For some this may mean a day school placement, for others full time education and care from child to adulthood.

- Encourages students to be active members of the community, positively contributing to adulthood and society.



- Support communication and sensory integration.






Bright Partnerships
